**BACKGROUND:**

City is proposing to install three 5' x 15' bus shelters that are ADA compliant, one in front of Rite Aid mounted on the existing sidewalk nearest the R-O-W line, the next in front of NAPA. Here the slab needs to be placed behind the sidewalk to mount the shelter on. The last one will be placed possibly in front of Cactus Deli (Victor Plaza).
