SUBJECT: Crushing of asphalt and concrete next to the city yard

BACKGROUND: The city has accumulated a large amount of concrete and asphalt riprap on the west side of the city yard; traditionally we collect these materials from the public and local construction projects throughout the city. The city crushes and uses this material as base for road construction projects within the city limits.

The city will share mobilization cost with Service Rock, our per ton cost for crushing will be \$2.75 we have approximately 10,000 tons to be crushed.

Price per ton: \$2.75

Tons to be crushed: 10,000

Mobilization: \$2,500

Total: \$30,000

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Authorize Staff to enter in a joint agreement with Service Rock for crushing operations of the material on the west side of the city yard.

FISCAL IMPACT: The estimated total of this project is \$30,000 to be taken out of funds 25 street materials.

ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION: The contractor will address all environmental issues.
