EXHIBIT "A"

Project Location: Vehicle to be based in California City and at least 75% of its annual mileage will be within the boundaries of the Kern County Air Pollution Control District.

Description of Project: Scrap 1989 Ford Ranger pickup and replace with a 2006 or 2007 Toyota Hybrid, (gas/electric), Prius.

Project Implementation Schedule: Project shall start on or after July 1, 2006 and shall be completed by June 30, 2007.

Maximum Project Grant Funds Approved: \$19,500.00 - This amount shall be reduced by any rebates or subsidies received by CONTRACTOR that were not considered in determining the amount to be paid by DISTRICT under this agreement.

Minimum Matching Project Funds or In-kind Services: \$5,673.00.

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
