

**Minutes for
CALIFORNIA CITY CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE
Thursday September 22, 2011
City Hall Council Chambers
California City, CA 93505**

The Chairman: R. Smith called the meeting to order, at 5:35 PM.

The following members were present: K. Collins, R. Salasavage, D. Schofield, R. Smith, R. Warren, D. Weaver, and J Wheeler.

Guests present. Public Works Director: Mike Bevins, City Council Member: Chuck McGuire, Park Commissioner: Chuck Hemingway

Adoption of Agenda: R. Warren made a motion to adopt the agenda and D. Schofield seconded it. The motion carried 7 - 0.

Old Business:

1. Updates for Special Tax projects and Business information

The Public Works Director: Mike Bevins started this presentation. He stated the **Community Center** demolition project was proceeding. It was \$200,000 over engineers estimate. The Architect is reevaluating the rebuild to get it within the bid and may even have a mock bid. **Mike Bevins continued** by stating there was lots of red tape involved with this project that has increased the cost of this project.

D. Weaver asked about the cupola? **Mike Bevins replied** that it would be built if the cost estimate allowed for this but there was lots of asbestos left for disposal.

D. Schofield asked where was the asbestos? **M. Bevins replied** it was in the main ballroom of the **Community Center.**

Mike Bevins stated that there was a project being considered tonight during the School Board meeting. This involved the fencing and right of way issues along **Ruche Blvd.**

Chuck McGuire stated that the **Special Tax Committee** got signs out. Color fliers are coming out soon and the meet and greet about the **Special Tax** will be underway soon.

2. Plans for Special Tax Audit

R. Smith Reports that **Roland Wilson** was in charge of the **Audit** to get started the first week in **October.**

Denise Schofield asked when the report would be ready. **R. Smith commented** that he hope to have it ready by the first week in **November.**

1. Members and Public Comments

R. Warren Commented that he has been working on getting an **Italian Restaurant** open on the South **California City Blvd.** and that it could seat 38 people.

J. Wheeler stated that he hope there were no signs against the **Special Tax.**
