
RE: Municipal Code: SDI Amendments

Title 1 of the Municipal Code contains definitions that apply throughout the Code, including section 1-3.07 which defines several SDI terms for the purposes of the entire Code. This definition is necessary because the materials on SDI appear in two places. Title 2 establishes various committees and commissions, including the SDI committee, and Title 9 describes how the SDI committee handles subdivision improvements.

As we have discussed, the enclosed ordinance eliminates Article 4 (enforcement) of Chapter 6 of Title 9 of the Municipal Code because it repeats materials contained in Title 2, Chapter 2.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF CALIFORNIA CITY AMENDING
THE CALIFORNIA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE
AS IT RELATES TO CODE MAINTENANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALIFORNIA
CITY as follows:**

1. Purpose.

This ordinance amends the California City Municipal Code to remove duplicate provisions.

2. Repeals.

Article 4 (commencing with section 9-6.401) of Chapter 6 of Title 9 of the California City Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

3. Other.

Except as provided herein, the California City Municipal Code is reaffirmed and readopted.
