

Special Announcement to Visitors to California City's Off-Road Riding Area

California City will be improving future services for Off-Highway Vehicle visitors in California City. These include:

- Improving Fresh Water filling stations at entry points to the Off-Road Riding Area
- Increase & improve the R.V. Dump stations to accommodate the increase of Off-Highway Vehicle visitors to California City.
- Increase the number of emergency crews stationed at Borax Bill Park, who respond to nearly 1,000 emergency calls each year in the Riding Area.
- Improve signage throughout the riding area.
- Improvements to Borax Bill Park.

The City does not recover 100% of the cost for local OHV recreation from the State of California "Green Sticker" program. The City is in the final stages of implementing a small "Street Operating Permit" fee to cover the rest of the costs. The fee would be used for Off-Highway Vehicle recreation improvements and maintenance. The fee will be set in January 2008. The cost of the permit will be \$5.00 - \$8.00/annually per Off-Road vehicle (Quads/Off-Road Motorcycles/Buggies etc.). The fee does not pertain to street licensed vehicles (Dual-Sports, 4x4's etc.). There will also be annual passes for "Fresh Water" fill-up and "R.V." Dump services so you can travel to California City without the extra weight of full storage tanks.
