..WINTER STORM TO IMPACT TRAVEL ACROSS THE MOUNTAINS AND DESERT THROUGH TUESDAY..

.A COLD WINTER STORM SYSTEM WILL AFFECT SOUTHWEST CALIFORNIA THROUGH TUESDAY..BRINGING HEAVY SNOW TO THE MOUNTAINS OF VENTURA AND LOS ANGELES COUNTIES EXCLUDING THE SANTA MONICA RANGE..AND THE ANTELOPE VALLEY. SNOW ACCUMULATIONS WILL RANGE FROM 6 TO 10 INCHES ACROSS THE ANTELOPE VALLEY TO 8 TO 14 INCHES ACROSS THE MOUNTAINS. LOCALLY HIGHER SNOWFALL TOTALS ARE POSSIBLE OVER THE MOUNTAINS OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY AND ACROSS THE SOUTHEAST PORTION OF THE ANTELOPE VALLEY. SNOW LEVELS WILL FALL TO 3500 FEET TODAY THEN TO 2500 TO 3000 FEET TONIGHT. COLD TEMPERATURES AND PERIODS OF HEAVY SNOWFALL WILL CREATE HAZARDOUS DRIVING CONDITIONS THROUGH TUESDAY MORNING.
